Application

• Product class I - Products for babies

Products for babies in context with this standard are all articles, basic materials and accessories, which are provided for the production of articles for babies and children up to 36 months.

• Product class II - Products with direct contact to skin

Skin contact articles are those which are worn with a large part of their surface in direct contact with the skin (e.g. blouses, shirts, underwear etc.).

• Product class III - Products without direct contact skin

No skin contact articles are those which are worn with only a small part of their surface in direct contact with the skin (e.g. shoulder pads, stuffings, linings etc.).

• Product class IV - Decoration material

This product class includes all articles, including initial products and accessories which are used for decorative purposes, such as tablecloths, textile wall coverings, furnishing fabrics and curtains, upholstery fabrics and floor coverings.

In accordance with the given declaration of conformity, each OEKO-TEX® certificate holder bears the sole responsibility for the quality of his articles. He is thus obliged to ensure this via suitable and sufficient spot checks. This commitment also includes the quality of goods purchased already pre-certified by OEKO-TEX®. Should parts of the quality assurance be transferred to other parties, the certifying body must be notified (see point 4 "Conformity declaration").

The OEKO-TEX® certification body is authorized to carry out spot checks to inspect the certified goods for their conformity. If the spot checks reveal an exceedance of limit values, additional tests must be carried out. The relevant costs will be charged to the certificate holder.

Should the applicant purchase materials from pre-certified OEKO-TEX® suppliers, he is responsible for checking the validity of the certificates issued to his suppliers.

If the term of validity of these certificates expires within the term of validity of the applicant's certificate, he is obliged to request updated or extended certificates from his suppliers.

Copies of updated certificates from suppliers should be presented as proof and for documentation purposes under the test number of the applicant's certificate.
